### Refund Policy

### Method of Payment

Registration may be made in person at our Box Office using cash, interact, cheque, VISA or Mastercard. Telephone registration requires VISA or MasterCard.

### Lunch and Snacks

Due to certain dietary restrictions for some children, camp participants are advised to bring a peanut-free and nut-free snack or lunch with them. For the full day camps, registrants can bring a bagged lunch or they can purchase lunch in our café. Staff and volunteers will provide all lunch hour supervision for children attending full day camps.

**Camp fees include drop-off starting at 8:30 a.m. and pick-up by 4:45 p.m.**

### Special Pre- and Post-Camp Supervision

\$30.00 + GST per week per participant. This program is ideal for parents who need to drop off their children earlier than 8:30 a.m. or pick-up later than 4:45 p.m. Morning pre-camp supervision will be held from 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and post-camp supervision will be held from 4:45 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. There will be a \$25.00 + GST late pick-up fee charged, for every 15 minutes (or portion thereof) beyond the 5:30 p.m. pick-up time.
